Tours in Kuala Lumpur

Batu Caves - Half-Day Tour (USD 10 Per Person)

The Batu Caves are known for the limestone rock inside which is more than 400 million years old.

We'll guide you through a comprehensive tour of the Caves and the many Hindu shrines around the area, including the wonderful main temple which is over a century old.

Our 3 and a-half-hour tour includes stops at Batu Caves temple, the world-renowned Royal Selangor Pewter factory and they can opt to watch batik craftsmen perform a traditional batik painting demonstration and get to admire the Beryl Chocolate Gallery as well.

Located just 8 miles away from the city of Kuala Lumpur in the Gombak district within the state of Selangor lies Batu Caves which is Malaysia's most visited Hindu shrine built in honor of Shiva's son, Lord Murugan and also the venue for the annual Hindu festival known as Thaipusam, held on the full moon between January and February. It's a festival celebrated by the Tamil community and its devotees named the Kavadi carriers who subject themselves to seemingly excruciating rituals mainly, body piercings). And although the sight is rather unpleasant for first-time visitors, it is a ritual that only devotees go through to attain a trance-like state which prevents them from feeling pain.

For more of an adventure, you can climb the ancient stairs leading to the entrance of the cave system (272 steps in all), to get a magnificent view of Kuala Lumpur when you reach the top. The crowning glory of the Hindu temple is the gigantic statue of Murugan standing atop the entire structure. At 140 feet, this is the second tallest statue devoted to any Hindu deity and it's the largest statue of a deity in the world.

Kuala Lumpur City Tour (USD 10 Per Person)

The capital city of Malaysia is an extremely popular travel destination for tourists planning to visit the Asian region. The equally impressive KL Tower has the highest viewpoint in KL because it's also the seventh tallest communication tower in the world which tourists can experience because it's open to the public The tour will drive past the picturesque and sprawling 91.6-hectare urban park known as Lake Gardens on your way to the National Monument, a historical structure that commemorates Malaysia's fight for freedom during World War II.

In the nearby National Mosque of Malaysia tourists can feast their eyes on its awe-inspiring modern construction built using a modern architectural style in reinforced concrete to symbolize the country's newly-gained independence. Plus, you can experience the unique balance of Eastern and Western architecture of the historic K.L. Railway Station, built in 1886 and continues to operate to this day.

Aquaria Klcc – Ticket (USD 20 Per Person)

The Aquaria KLCC is an oceanarium located beneath Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre within Kuala Lumpur City Centre in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

Featuring 60,000 square feet (5,600 m²) in two levels with a 90-metre (300 ft) underwater tunnel, Aquaria KLCC houses over 250 different species and over 5,000 land and aquatic animals from Malaysia and around the world. Interactive information kiosks on fish and turtle conservation. It includes a themed retail area of about 5,000 square feet (460 m²).

Aquaria KLCC is based on the journey of water from the land to the sea. The journey starts in the misty highlands, down through rivers, through the rainforest and mangroves to the coral reefs into the deep blue sea. There is a large food court just outside the aquarium with many choices of food.

See the world's most exotic water and land animals at Aquaria KLCC's 60,000-square-foot oceanarium consisting of 15 exhibits over eight areas. Not to be missed, walk the 90-metre underwater tunnel as an array of curious aquatic species swim all around you. Visit one of the top five aquariums in Asia at Aquaria KLCC and witness the state-of-the-art aquarium and the 90-metre-long underwater walkway.

Genting Highlands -Private Tour (USD 40 Per Person)

Genting Highlands has also gained a reputation for being called the Las Vegas of Malaysia. It's home to the only land-based casino in the country.

Genting Highlands is an integrated resort development comprising hotels, casinos, shopping malls, and the latest Skyworlds Theme Park in Pahang, perched on the peak of Gunung Ulu Kali at 1,800 meters high. Nestled near the border of Selangor about 35km away from Kuala Lumpur, Genting represents a popular weekend getaway from KL, connected by highways, roads, and cable cars via Awana Skyway.

On a clear day, the peak overlooks lush valleys of rainforest stretching towards KL, a breathtaking view for visitors as they enjoy the cooling weather and serene mountain environment. Also located around Genting in the surrounding valley are many tourist attractions including rustic villages, culinary hotspots, homestay retreats, nature destinations, and more.

You can find a full-scale theme park atop the mountain and the government has officially given it the title, The City of Entertainment. The tour will jump off from the city of Kuala Lumpur to begin a 45-minute drive to the Genting Highlands. The Genting Highlands casinos can only be reached through a cable car and while you're on the cable car you will get to enjoy the breathtaking view of KL you can only see when you visit the mountain. Fresh highland air and the relaxing cold temperature in Genting Highlands is the best getaway tour from the busy life in the city.

Sunway Lagoon Theme Park – Ticket (USD 40 Per Person)

Sunway Lagoon, 20+ km from Kuala Lumpur city, has the **largest wave pool in the world** has an impressive 139,800 ft.² pool area where guests can surf on. It also has the **world's largest man-made beach** to complete the entire surf/beach experience.

During this tour, you will have access to the water park as well as the nearby amusement park. These parks are also home to the **highest slingshot ride in Asia and the first interactive zoo in Malaysia**, respectively.

Malacca City Tour With Melaka Historic Centre (USD 55 Per Person)
